- 1 - Choose a crib card like this one on the right...
- 2 - Fill in the all of your details on the crib card

Fill in your name spelt phonetically as on the card

Example: If your name is David you would spell your name as DELTA ALPHA VICTOR INDIA DELTA

Check everything so you can read it out confidently when the time comes.

- 3 - Take two QSL Cards and bring a pen with you when you come to the microphone



- 4 - Pass your greetings message (read out your card) when you are prompted

- 5 - Make a note of the name of the person to whom you have spoken (over the air) and which Scout Troop they are from.

- 6 - Fill in the front of both of the QSL Cards with your name, their name and their Scout Troop and ask the Radio Logger to fill in the backs of both cards for you.



- 8 - Leave one card with the Radio Logger and keep your card as a souvenir of your achievement!
